Thank you so much for your interest in serving as a Summer Missionary at Ponderosa Bible Camp. We are currently accepting applications for 2010 Summer Camp Counselors with positions available for 4 girls and 4 guys. Three Certified Lifeguard positions are also available. If you are not certified but interested in becoming so please contact us about our dates for Lifeguard training.

Requirements for 2010 Summer Missionaries:

- Must be strong Christian, able to confidently share the gospel and your personal salvation experience.
- Must currently be having daily quiet times, prayer, and Bible study and be able to share what God is currently teaching you.
- Must be a Single adult age 18 or older.
- Must have completed high school at least one year ago (June 2009) or before.
- Must work well with, and *LOVE* kids. (Have lots of patience with kids!)
- Fun, outgoing personality required
- Must enjoy the outdoors!
- Required Activities: swimming, canoeing, hiking, field & gym games, and having fun with your campers.
- Must be in good health able to participate in many physical activities.
- Willing to spend 5 weeks of your summer serving the Lord
- Must be available June 13 - July 17, 2010
- Must be able to submit to the authority of the Camp Director and other Full-Time Staff
- Background check and References required
- Must respectfully adhere to the Camp Dress Code (see attached)

Should you be accepted to serve at Ponderosa Bible Camp this summer, here is some information regarding your income:

Ponderosa Bible Camp's Summer Missionary Program is designed to provide an opportunity for qualified individuals to work at camp as a Counselor/Cabin Leader or Lifeguard without experiencing a significant decrease in the income they could earn working in a non-ministry environment during the summer. All Counselors and Lifeguards are considered Summer Missionaries.

Counselors are paid \$200 per week plus room and board is provided. In addition to your salary, all counselors will be allowed to **raise up to \$2,000 additional in Summer Missionary support** by contacting your church, family and friends. (This will make up the difference of what you could be earning if you were working full-time at a secular job this summer.) The money you raise can go to you in your paycheck **or** you can chose to have this money sent directly to the college of your choice as a Scholarship. (We learned that the greater your "Adjusted Gross Income", the less FASFA money you will receive. So if we send this money to your college in the form of a Scholarship it does not have to be included on your W-2 form).

You will need to supply us the names and addresses of the people and/or churches you would like to ask for support and then I will write a letter on your behalf asking that they consider supporting you as a Summer Missionary this summer.

All gifts/donations sent in for your support are **tax-deductible** for the donor and all will go directly to you. Ponderosa Bible Camp will use none of these gifts for operating expenses. We only take out social security taxes.

Checks should be made payable to Ponderosa Bible Camp. Donors should not put your name on checks, but enclose a note naming you as the person they wish to sponsor.

(optional: foam mattress pad)
Pictures or room decorations to help you feel at home
Bath Towels and washcloths, Beach towels for pool and River
Hair dryer, curlers, Toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, etc.
Light jacket, sweater or sweatshirts
Alarm clock, radio, tape or CD player (please do not bring secular music)

Staff and campers are REQUIRED to adhere to the "Camp Dress Code" as follows,
As camp staff you must be above reproach and be the example to your campers of submitting to the Dress Code without issue. (Most of this applies to females)

It is our desire that Ponderosa Bible Camp be a place where young men and young women can escape "the ways of the world" during their stay at camp, a place where they can focus their eyes and their hearts on their relationship with Jesus, a place where they are not "tempted" by the flesh.
Therefore campers and staff are REQUIRED to adhere to the "Camp Dress Code" as follows,
be sure to remember "What not to Wear":

- All shorts must be below fingertips, when standing (including gym shorts)
- Skirts and Skorts must be No shorter than 1 inch above the knee
- Tank-top straps must be at least 1½ inches wide
- We have a No visible waistline (front or back) policy. Waistline must remain covered when bending, reaching, playing games (you can wear a long tank tucked-in under shorter shirts to keep you covered).
- We have a No visible cleavage policy
- We have a No visible bra straps policy
- We have a No visible underwear policy
- Girls: No swimsuits that reveal your waist or cleavage. 1-piece suits are preferred for female counselors.
- No Speedos for guys.
- PLEASE do not bring a bikini swimsuit, or thong underwear to camp (we have had parents complain in the past after their daughters returned home commenting on such.)
